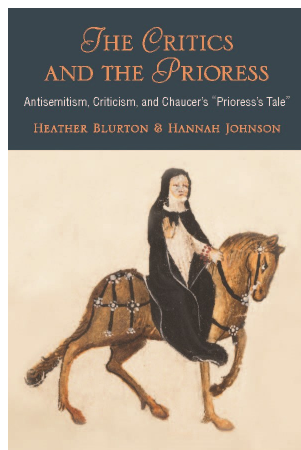
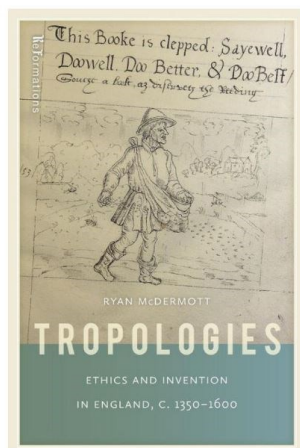

Steven Justice is Chancellor's Professor of English at Berkeley. He is interested in the forms of thought that shape and differentiate cultural enterprises like literature, philosophy, and religious practice, and in the forms of self-reflection built into each of them. His book *Adam Usk's Secret* was published by the University of Pennsylvania Press in 2015, and Professor Justice is currently writing a book on medieval exegesis of the Song of Songs. He is also the author of *Writing and Rebellion: England in 1381* (1994) and several recent essays: “Eucharistic Miracle and Eucharistic Doubt” (2012); “Chaucer’s History-Effect” (2013); and “‘Shameless’: Augustine, After Augustine, and Way After Augustine” (2014).
